Oral health issues may be a harbinger of other problems

<u>Probiotics reduce halitosis symptoms but not cause</u>

Probiotics such as Lactobacillus salivarius, Lactobacillus reuteri, Streptococcus salivarius and Weissella cibaria may provide temporary relief for patients with halitosis, according to research published in BMJ Open. The supplements can ease symptoms in the short term by reducing volatile sulfur compounds in the mouth, but they do not have a significant effect on underlying causes such as tongue coating and plaque.
